RE: COVID-19 vaccination for aged 5-11 years

Children aged 5 to 11 years old in a clinical risk group, or who are a household contact of someone who is immunosuppressed, are now being offered two child doses of the COVID-19 vaccination 8 weeks apart.

We are writing to you because your child is eligible to receive the COVID-19 vaccine at your local Health and Social Care Trust site (see www.nidirect.gov.uk/covid-vaccine). Alternatively, the school health vaccination team will attend **Oakwood Special School on Wednesday** 2 nd February 2022 to offer your child this vaccine.

If you wish your child to receive the COVID-19, vaccination in school please contact the telephone number below to arrange an appointment. You will be required to bring your child to school at their appointment time and take your child home after they have received their vaccine.

Your child **cannot** receive their COVID-19 vaccine if they have had a positive covid test within 28 days of their vaccine date.

If your child is currently unwell, self-isolating or waiting for a COVID-19 test you should delay vaccination until later.

If your child is absent from school on the day the vaccination clinic is running, you can book an appointment at one of the paediatric sessions in the local Trust on the online booking system using the QR code below or through the website https://covid-19.hscni.net/get-vaccinated/ Please ensure that your child is accompanied at the clinic by a person with parental responsibility.
